Homeopathy: Medicine for the New Millennium, George Vithoulkas
Vithoulkas can be credited more than any other one individual for the current availability of classical homeopathy. This is the 28th edition of his classic introduction to homeopathy for the general public.

Homeopathy: A Rational Choice in Medicine, Mo Morrish
A short introductory text for the person who wants to know more about homeopathy, either before deciding whether to consult a homeopathy, or after becoming curious from personal experience of homeopathy.

Homeopathy for Today's World (previously published as *The Other Song: Discovering Your Parallel Self*), Rajan Sankaran
Sankaran, the world-famous Indian homeopath, theoretician, and system builder, writes for the general public to explain his philosophy of what homeopathy is all about.

Sensations: The Healing Power of Homeopathy, Ildiko Ran
A behind-the-scenes look at how the homeopath works with the information from the interview, using Sankaran's methods. Written for both homeopaths and the general public.

The Complete Homeopathy Handbook, Miranda Castro
This is a good text for anyone who wants to try self-help homeopathy, for first aid for injuries and minor illnesses.

Understanding Homeopathy, Homeopathic Understanding,
Julian Carlyon
Not designed for the casual reader, this book requires a basic understanding of homeopathy and an interest in philosophy and/or theoretical psychology. This is probably *not* a good book to read just before an initial homeopathic consultation, as it may make homeopathy seem dauntingly complex. However, for the reader with the proper interest and background, this is a well-written and thought-provoking book.
